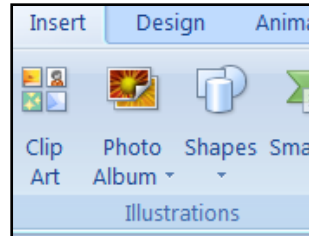




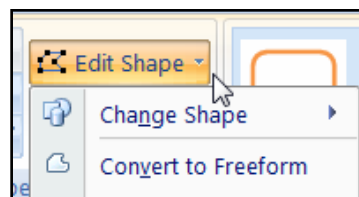
Freeform a Shape in PowerPoint 2007

This works on inserting an existing PowerPoint shape and then turning it into a freeform object—which means you can then change its shape to suit yourself.

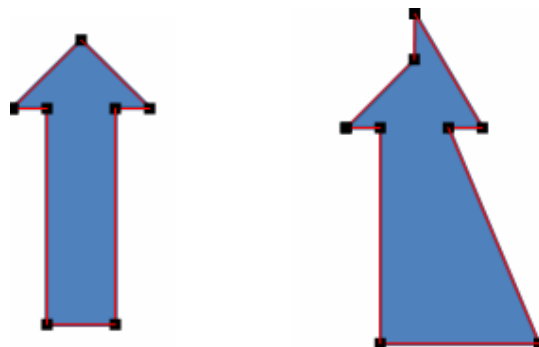
1. Position yourself in a slide and click on the **Insert** tab.
2. Click the **Shapes** button.



3. Select the shape you wish to freeform—in this example I have chosen a block arrow—and drag it to size on the slide.
4. Select the object and then click the **Format** tab.
5. Click the **Edit Shapes** button.
6. Select **Convert To Freeform**.



7. Click the **Edit Shapes** button again.
8. Select **Edit Points**.
10. Click and drag on the little black selection handles to change the shape to anything you want.
